Market Comments: Auctioneer - STEELE HATHWAY

In today's sale numbers rose by 1400. Elders yarded 2799 up about 600 on last week and were 3rd sale representing 37% of the yarding. The lamb yarding was competitive throughout BRM, V&V WALSH, HILLSIDE, STATEWIDE and FLETCHERS were the main competitors. All grades of lambs were available. Suckers starting to arrive in larger lines and weight getting better each week. WAMMCO did not operate in our lamb yarding. Merino ewe lambs / hoggets were again very well supported by graziers with one pen reaching \$210. Mutton of all grades were available and FLETCHERS, WAMMCO, PRIDE and BRM were the main competitors. Heavy mutton saw a slightly softer market but light weights gained slightly. Approximately 1000 mutton were yarded this week. Green tag ewes and wethers and purple tag hoggets supported well by KARNET and WAMMCO. Elders sale averaged \$179.04
